(b)	Withdrawal of Summer Quarter for B. Tech/ B. Arch program under Appendix -IX vis-à-vis Opportunity for improvement	<p>Senate was of the view that the withdrawal of provisions of summer Quarter be made effective from session 2012-13 for the students admitted in 2012 onward only. The provision of Summer Quarter be continued for the existing students till they pass out.</p> <p>It further directed that the transitory regulation of re-registration for backlog failed courses by students for improvement in class assessment marks need not be extended further, as this causes time table clash, and academic burden/ load on student increases.</p>
