The decisions regarding academic regulation taken in the 14th Senate will be applicable for the students admitted from 2013-14 onwards. ii. Regarding the Agenda SNT 14.21, the Senate did not approve the recruit rules in 4 tier Cadre system. So, it is assumed to be deleted from the minutes of the 14th Senate meeting. iii. A correction is needed in the Agenda SNT 14.18: For PEC only first two criteria are required but for BOS all the criteria are as mentioned in the agenda proposal. It may be assumed to be corrected to this extent.

(d)	Correction of discrepancies in published result for Odd Semester Examination in December 2013, Special Exam 2013 and for End Semester Examination May 2014.	The corrections were approved by the Senate. If there is any discrepancy in the published results for Odd Semester Examination in December 2013, Special Exam 2013 and for End Semester Examination May 2014, it should also be corrected within 20 days. After the correction, if it is found that some students have passed, they will be declared to have passed during the Academic Session 2013-14. Such passed students may also be given degree in absentia and Chairman is authorized to approve the result.
SNT 15.4	Any other matter(s)	<p>i. It was decided that the result of remaining students must be published before one week of the date of commencement of the Mid-semester Examination for the current Semester, i.e., 13th October 2014.</p> <p>The P.I (Exam) promised to prepare and publish the result by 30th September 2014</p> <p>ii. The result must be published in time in future. Prof. D. K. Singh (ECE) will assist the Exam section to prepare the pending results of all the Ph. D students at NIT Patna.</p> <p>iii. The Academic Section and MIS cell should complete the process of registration for pending cases within three days of the publication of results. The Examination section should be given three days to prepare for mid Semester Examination during the current semester.</p>
